In response to community health and safety concerns regarding the COVID-19 virus, **the decision has been made to close Kearney Catholic High School for the next two weeks (March 16-29). This includes all scheduled school and non-school events, practices, and competitions.**

In preparation for a potential extended closure we are asking that students/and or parents clear out their lockers, taking all books and all other items home for learning and cleaning purposes.

- **The school will be open on Monday from 10AM to 5PM for healthy students (or a family member) for pick up of books, chromebooks and all personal items. Please keep social distancing in mind. This is an in and out event.**
- **Faculty and Staff members please report at 8:30AM for the day on Monday.**
- **We are making preparations for off-site learning. We will apprise you of when this will be rolled out. This is not an absolute time frame but possible implementation may occur the week of March 23rd. The success of our off-site learning efforts will take flexibility from our staff and our students, and the support of our parents and families. Students will need to check their school email on a regular basis.**

The length of this closure will be dependent upon how the events of the next two weeks unfold. We will continue to communicate with the KCHS community as needed. Please give your full attention to any future communications from Kearney Catholic.

Please continue to pray for all who have been or will be affected by the COVID-19 virus and that this pandemic's effects are short lived.
